

Remember to be S.A.F.E.R.

With Solid Wood Packing Material (SWPM)

- **S**earch SWPM for invasive insects
- **A**sk where your pallets come from
- **F**ix any problems through containment
- **E**ducate clients about invasive pests
- **R**eport detections to authorities

LOOK
for tunnels



Insect larvae can live in and eat wood, creating tunnels and exit holes

WATCH
for any pests



Check SWPM for presence of larvae or adult insects.

REPORT
anything suspicious



Quarantine any suspect SWPM (cover with tarp and secure) and contact your local agricultural authority.
