Definition: Solid wood used or intended for use with cargo and conveyances to support and/or prevent damage.

- There are **regulated** and **exempt** types of wood packaging material.
- Regulated material includes, but not limited to, dunnage, crating, pallets, packing blocks, drums, cases, and skids.





Improving our metrics:


- USDA and CBP investment in our non-compliant WPM data collection

U.S. Ports of Entry




Heat map at Ports of Entry where WPM issues have been encountered in FY24


